1. NEW LEADER ESSENTIALS

This 2 hour course is the first requirement for becoming a "Trained Boy Scout Leader".

2. SCOUTMASTER/ASST SCOUTMASTER POSITION SPECIFIC TRAINING

This course provides the new Boy Scout Leader with the essential information necessary to develop and lead a successful boy run troop. All aspects of Troop Leadership are covered, with special emphasis on the "patrol method" "advancement" "troop activity planning", "youth leadership development", and the "outdoor program".

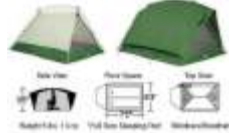


2a. TROOP COMMITTEE

This is required training for committee members and committee chairs responsible for Troop administration

3. OUTDOOR LEADERSHIP SKILLS TRAINING

This is the final training course necessary for becoming a "Trained Boy Scout Leader". It is also for all Scouters who want to increase their knowledge of outdoor skills and effective teaching.



Outdoor Leadership Skills training is a two evening and one weekend outdoor training program. You will be introduced to the "Effective Teaching" methods so that your Troop can be more proficient in their skill instruction. It will also increase the depth of your knowledge in five key areas: Survival, Team Building, Camping, Cooking, and Back Packing. The course uses a "hands-on" approach, and you will be able to product test camping equipment as well as other pro active activities. The instructors in this course have staffed numerous other training courses and are familiar with every aspect of Scouting



This course is held twice a year at Camp Kiwanis. You will **learn and practice:**
